

# CENTRAL COMMUNITY TRANSIT

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

Central Community Transit is seeking proposals from qualified property owners, brokers, or development firms for the sale of land suitable for the construction of a new transit facility. The purpose of this RFP is to identify and acquire a parcel of land that meets the operational, locational, and physical needs of the Agency's planned facility.

## 2. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The proposed transit facility will support bus operations, maintenance, administrative offices, and future transitoriented development. The facility is a strategic investment to improve service delivery, enhance fleet operations, and accommodate projected ridership and service growth.

## 3. PARCEL REQUIREMENTS

#### **Minimum Criteria:**

- **Size:** Minimum 3-6 acres (expandable preferred)
- Zoning: Must be zoned commercial or able to be zoned commercial
- **Topography:** Site should be generally level and developable
- Location: Within 5 miles of downtown Willmar
- Access: Direct access to arterial roads; proximity to highways/interstates preferred
- Utilities: Access to electricity, water, sewer, and telecommunications infrastructure
- Environmental Conditions: Site must be free of known hazardous conditions or be remediable

#### **Preferred Criteria:**

- Proximity to current/planned transit corridors
- Potential for transit-oriented development or future expansion
- Existing improvements suitable for interim use

## 4. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Respondents must include the following in their proposal:

- 1. Cover Letter
- 2. Property Information
  - o Legal description of the parcel
  - Site address and/or parcel number(s)
  - o GIS survey and/or aerial maps
  - Current zoning and land use
  - o Environmental Site Assessment reports (if applicable)

#### 3. Price and Terms

- Asking price
- Proposed terms and contingencies

## 4. Ownership Documentation

o Proof of ownership or exclusive marketing rights

#### 5. Disclosures

- o Known encumbrances, liens, or legal issues
- o Any past or pending environmental or legal actions

#### 6. Other Relevant Information

- Photographs of the site
- o Future development plans (if any)
- o Timeline for site availability

## 5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following factors:

- Suitability of site for intended use
- Location relative to service area and accessibility
- Parcel size and expansion potential
- Price and value
- Environmental and infrastructure readiness
- Timeline for acquisition and possession
- Development or partnership opportunities (if applicable)

The Agency reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive irregularities or informalities, and to negotiate with any or all proposers.
